POLICIES

- 1. After-Hours Agencies must register with Borderlands and receive an ID card before they are able to pick up produce at a P.O.W.W.O.W. host site. They must present this ID card when picking up produce. You will receive a new ID card annually, if you respond to the annual email sent asking you to update your application.
- 2. Borderlands' P.O.W.W.O.W. After-Hours Program is meant to help small organizations whose budget is small and need help with meeting their mission through nutritious food distribution for their participants and or their organization.
- 3. After-Hours Agencies may only pick up left-over produce at one Borderlands' P.O.W.W.O.W. Agency Host Site per week; a <u>maximum of 10 boxes</u> per variety will be implemented unless there is only one variety then 20 boxes may be taken of the one variety, if available.
- 4. After-Hours Agencies must email yolanda_soto@hotmail.com the number of boxes and product type that were picked up at the host site for that week-end, please include the name of the Host Site attended, with date and use the report form to email form.
- 5. After-Hours Agencies may not pick up produce until after the Agency Host Site is finished distributing to supporters and has closed down.
- 6. You are receiving this rescued produce at no contribution cost to your organization. We ask that you submit your testimonials/pictures to show how we are helping you help your program. Also, be prepared to stay when picking up to help with cleanup at the host site.

- 8. Borderlands Produce Rescue is committed to implementing inclusive practices in the workplace and throughout our programs.
